

SERVICE, TEAM AND MERIT AWARDS FOR PARENT/COMMUNITY MEMBERS, SECONDARY STUDENTS AND DISTRICT STAFF

Value of Program

The Edmonton Public Schools Board of Trustees believes that it is important to honour the outstanding leadership, accomplishments, contributions and achievements of parents, community members, secondary students (Grades 7 to 12) and staff. Such recognition acknowledges the role and value of educational partnerships in achieving student success.

Nomination Process

The Board has identified three types of recognition (service, team and merit) for each of the following groups: parent/community members, secondary students and staff (teaching, support, custodial, maintenance and exempt). Consider nominating deserving individuals or groups from the community, your school or central services for the 2017-2018 school year.

Schools or District locations may submit **a maximum of 3 nominations**. In order to avoid too many nominations being submitted from one location, we suggest each school/DU appoints someone to coordinate their submissions.

** If a principal or DU administrator is not already a nominator, they must sign off on the nomination before the submission will be accepted.*

Nominators' names may be shared with the nominee and the nominee's principal or DU administrator.

Recognition Process

All nominees meeting the criteria will receive a certificate and will be acknowledged in the fall of 2018.

Nominee/team names, photos and nomination stories may be shared on epsb.ca, StaffRoom and District social media channels.

NOMINATION AND SCREENING PROCESS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Before submission, nomination forms must be signed by the nominee or team representative, all three nominators and the principal or DU administrator (if not already a nominator). Nominators CANNOT be members of the nominated group. A maximum of three nominations will be accepted from a single location. The following information must be provided in each nomination: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Type of recognition: service, team or merit. Nominee's name, category (i.e. student, parent, staff, community partner/volunteer), school or location being supported and principal or DU administrator name. For teams, provide names for each team member. Each team member must provide consent. Brief description of the significant milestones or experiences that contributed to the accomplishment or achievement. Supporting documents: signed letters of endorsement from the nominators (each nominator must provide a written letter outlining the rationale for their support) supplemented with high resolution photos, newspaper articles or video clips. *Nominators must ensure they have consent from any individuals appearing in photos, videos or articles submitted. These materials may be used for online acknowledgement purposes. Photos and other supporting nomination documents may be emailed to districtrecognition@epsb.ca. In the subject line, please include name of nominee or team and the school or DU name. Nomination screening will be facilitated by the staff in Communications.
