## **REGULATION**

1. All bomb threats shall be reported immediately by the school to the Edmonton Police Service (911). The following pertinent information shall be provided:

- a. who received the call;
- b. the time the call was received;
- c. what was said by the person making the threat;
- d. description of the person making the threat (male/female; youth/adult; accent, etc.);
- e. what action has been taken.
- 2. Police advice regarding further action shall be followed by the school.
- 3. Security Services (Emergency Line 780-429-3772) shall be notified by the school immediately after the police have been called.
- 4. Schools shall follow site bomb threat protocols as outlined in their school's emergency plans.
- 5. An alert email shall be sent notifying the Superintendent of Schools, Assistant Superintendents and key central personnel.
- 6. A Division security consultant shall complete an incident report on all bomb threats.
- 7. Security Services shall maintain a record of all threats to schools.
