Board Policy CH.BP - Framework for Policy Development and Review

**Education Act** 

#### **ISSUE**

The Policy Review Committee is presenting its 2019-2020 work plan to the Board of Trustees (the Board) for approval.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Policy Review Committee is responsible for assisting the Board by ensuring that policies submitted for Board approval are developed and reviewed in accordance with Board Policy CH.BP Framework for Policy Development and Review.

On June 25, 2019, the Board elected three Policy Review Committee members for 2019-2020. Since then, the committee has held two meetings, reviewed the committee's work over the past three years, assessed and planned policy development required through new provincial legislation, and established a Policy Review work plan for 2019-2020.

#### **RELATED FACTS**

This year's work plan addresses the following:

- **Provincial Legislation alignment:** The Board is responsible for ensuring all Division policies are in alignment with provincial legislation; this year this work will address the *Education Act*, which came into effect September 2019 and the 21 new provincial regulations. The work to ensure this alignment includes:
  - Revising all references to the School Act across board policies to reflect the new Education Act.
    - An omnibus report will be brought forward to the Board that includes all board policies that simply require this reference change.
  - Bringing forward individual board policies requiring more extensive changes to reflect alignment to the *Education Act*; these will come forward individually as work is completed.
  - Aligning existing board policy addressing school closure with the Education Act.
  - Developing five new board policies to address:
    - Dispute resolution
    - Use of school buildings
    - Surplus reserve land

- Board Policy GGAB.BP Multicultural Education: The Committee initiated work on Board Policy GGAB.BP Multicultural Education as part of their 2016-2017 policy review work plan. This year the committee will continue to work with the Multiculturalism and Cultural Diversity Advisory Committee, established in spring 2019, to support the revision of the existing policy. This year's work will continue to be informed by the advisory committee and a draft of the policy will be brought to Board for first reading.
- **Board Policy GGAJ.BP Early Years:** Work to review this policy began in 2018-2019; to support this review, the Committee held engagement sessions with parents, community agencies, front-line staff and Division leaders. This engagement served to inform the first draft of the policy revision, which the Committee will bring forward to the Board for first reading in early 2020.
- Board Policy DK.BP District Technology: The Committee brought Board Policy DK.BP District
  Technology to a public board meeting on May 28, 2019, for first reading. It was then open for public
  feedback through an online survey. This feedback will inform final revision to the policy and it will be
  brought forward to the Board for second and third reading in early 2020.
- **Board Policy AB.BP Appeals:** This policy will be revised to align with requirements of the *Education Act*, and with consideration to its interplay with the new Dispute Resolution policy and Board Policy CHA.BP Delegation of Authority.
- **Board Policy CHA.BP Delegation of Authority:** This policy will be revised to align with requirements of the *Education Act*, and with consideration to its interplay with Board Policy AB.BP Appeals and the new Dispute Resolution policy.
- Board Policy GIBP.BP Integrated School Library Learning Commons: Once the new Ministerial
  Order on Student Learning has been approved by the Minister of Education, the Committee will
  proceed with reviewing Board Policy GIBP.BP Integrated School Library Learning Commons.
- **Anaphylaxis Policy:** In alignment with new legislation *Protection of Students with Life-Threatening Allergies Act*, the Committee will develop a new policy.

At this time, the Committee does not anticipate the use of financial resources to support their work this year.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That the Policy Review work plan 2019-2020 be approved.
