1. Confirmation of Board Chair

The Acting Board Chair advised that Trustee Estabrooks resigned as Board Chair on October 5, 2023.

The Acting Board Chair called for nominations for the position of Board Chair.

Trustee O'Keefe nominated Trustee Kusiek. Trustee Kusiek accepted the nomination.

The Acting Board Chair, seeing that there were no further nominations, closed the nominations and declared herself elected by acclamation as Board Chair.

2. Representative Assignment

The Board Chair advised that Trustee O'Keefe stepped down from her role as the Board's representative on the Edmonton Public Schools Foundation on September 26, 2023.

The Board Chair called for nominations for one Trustee representative to serve on the Edmonton Public Schools Foundation Board of Governors.

Trustee O'Keefe nominated Trustee Hole. Trustee Hole accepted the nomination.

The Board Chair, seeing that there were no further nominations, closed the nominations and declared Trustee Hole elected to the Edmonton Public Schools Foundation Board of Governors.

3. <u>Vacated Board Vice-Chair Position</u>

The Board Chair called for nominations for the recently vacated position of Board Vice-Chair. This person will also serve as the Chair of the Caucus Committee.

Trustee Nelson nominated Trustee Sawyer. Trustee Sawyer accepted the nomination.

Trustee Hole nominated Trustee Sumar. Trustee Sumar accepted the nomination.

At that meeting, Trustees Sawyer and Sumar agreed to discuss the role of TEBA representative and report back to public Board. The Board Chair announced that Trustee Sumar will serve as the Board's TEBA representative. She thanked Trustee Sumar for agreeing to serve in this role.
