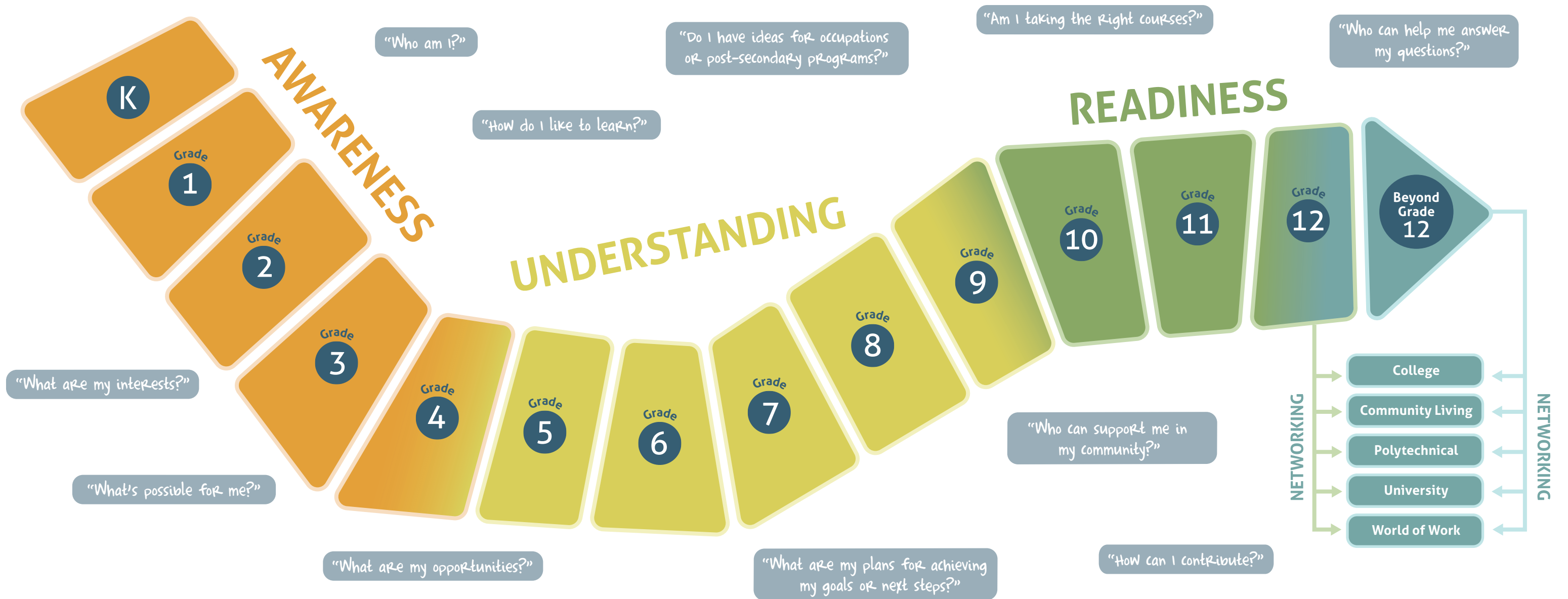


Career Pathways Model
